## BROWNIES Ages 6-8

**Animal Antics** (activities 2,3,4,5)  
 Find what makes a pet different from a wild animal and have fun playing animal games.  
 (1 hour) taught year round

**Sky Above, Ground Below** (activities 1,3,4,5)  
 In the air and underground, discover some of Nature's amazing secrets that most people never even notice.  
 (1 hour) taught April – Nov.



**Exploring Ecology** (activities 1,2,4,6)  
 Explore the outdoors and search for the connections between living things. Take part in a project to help wildlife.  
 (1 hour) taught April – Nov.

**The Five Senses** (activities 1,2,3,4)  
 How "scent"-sitive are you? Put your senses to the test and learn how animals depend on their senses to survive.  
 (1 hour) taught year round

**Wildlife Wonders** (activities 1,3,4,6)  
 Watch out for wildlife, especially underfoot, as we explore animal homes. Find out what animals are eating and wearing during the changing seasons.  
 (1 hour) taught year round



## JUNIORS Ages 8-11

**Everything is Connected** (activities 1,2,3,4,5,8)  
 Find out what it is like to be an ecologist, a person who figures out the connections between plants, animals, and the environment. Have fun exploring and playing games outdoors.  
 (1½ hours) taught April – Nov.



**Learning Rocks** (activities 1,3,4,7,8,9)  
 Dig right in to geology and find out why nothing on Earth is permanent. See what is going on underground and make a rock collection and a fossil to take home.  
 (1½ hours) taught April – Nov.

**Wildlife Everywhere** (activities 2,3,5,6,7,8)  
 Practice using scientific tools and learn ways to observe elusive wildlife. Discover which animals you should keep your distance from.  
 (1½ hours) taught year round

**Natural Surroundings** (activities 2,4,5,6,8,9)  
 Discover many different ways to have lots of fun outdoors. Learn some ways you can help the environment as you practice the basics of bird-watching and other outdoor skills.  
 (1½ hours) taught year round



**Discovering Science** (activities 1,4,5,8,9,10)  
 Create fun and amazing experiments just like real scientists do. Check out optical illusions that will confuse and tickle your brain.  
 (1½ hours) taught year round
